


A warm welcome to all our learners and staff returning to school for Term 3, 2025! We also extend a special welcome to our new learners and parents who are joining our school.

- School Opens on Tuesday 9th September 2025. All learners are expected to report to school.

- On Fridays school ends at 13:00 hours (Primary and PCELC).
 Secondary section knocks off at 13:20 hours.
- From week 11 to the end of the Term, school ends at 13:00 hours.

- Punctuality: Primary and Secondary school learners should be in school by 07:15 hours. Lessons start at 07:30 hours. Learners arriving in school after 07:30 hours will not be allowed in school.
- Early Learning Centre should be in school between 07:20 hours and 08:00 hours. Learners arriving after 08:00 hours will be sent back.
 - Late pick up: Learners should be collected within the hour after school ends: before 17:00 hours and 14:00 hours respectively. Learners picked up late will incur a charge of K500 per hour. Your cooperation in adhering to the school times will be highly appreciated
